

Saka, the star in the making

Bukayo Saka was put on the field to turn possession into penetration, to create chances for an England team that had scored only one goal in two matches at the European Championship.

He did all that and more, but he still came up short in one particular area.

Raheem Sterling scored the only goal in England's 1-0 victory over the Czech Republic on Tuesday by heading in a cross from Jack Grealish that flew just over the jumping Saka's own head.

"It was a great cross from Jack and Raheem was there for the goal," the 19-year-old midfielder said.

"I almost got there but I'm just not quite tall enough."

He was good enough, however: Good enough to get UEFA's player of the match award. And maybe even good enough to stay in the starting lineup when England plays its next Euro 2020 match in the round of 16.

"He earned that opportunity (to play) tonight and he has grabbed it," England coach Gareth Southgate said.

England already knew it had advanced to the round of 16 before the game at Wembley Stadium had started, allowing Southgate to try something new with an attack that has created very little since the tournament began. The two new something were Saka and Greal-

Record-equalling win for Spain

Spaniard re-write books in Euro win at Slovakia's expense; Sweden beat Poland, enter the round of 16

Spain booked their place in the Euro 2020 round of 16 in style as they ended the hopes of Slovakia with a win that equalled the competition final tournament record margin of victory. Heartbreak for Poland who were on fire in their fixture against Sweden. Despite going two goals down, Poland dared to dream of beating Sweden after two spectacular goals from Lewandowski, but an injury time goal from Sweden's Claesson sealed their fate. Spain were ruthless against Slovakia. The Spaniards were again misfiring in the first half. Morata missed a penalty, while Spain struggled to convert their chances. But an own goal from Slovakia turned their fortunes. Laporte scored deep into added time in the first half. After that it was all Spain. Three more goals followed from Sarabia and Ferran Torres and the third being a second own goal for the match from Slovakia. Germany and Hungary shared two goals, with the latter making an exit from the championship with 3 points and finishing in the bottom of the table. Germany make it to the last 16, at the match played at the Football

Arena in Munich. At the Puskas Arena in Budapest, Cristiano Ronaldo converted twice from the penalty spot as they held table toppers France.

Martin Dubravka saved an early Alvaro Morata penalty but the keeper's freak own goal broke the deadlock. Aymeric Laporte made it 2-0 on half-time and Pablo Sarabia and Ferran Torres produced impressive finishes before another own goal. Slovakia's goal difference means they will not progress as one of the four best third-placed teams; Spain ended second due to Sweden's dramatic defeat of Poland and face Croatia in the round of 16 in Copenhagen on Monday.

Spain needed a win definitely to go through without relying on Poland not beating Sweden but despite a bright start it was ominous when, after Jakub Hromada brought down Koke in the box, Morata's 12th-minute penalty was saved by Dubravka.

However, on the half-hour the Slovakia goalkeeper ended up palming a dipping ball into his own net after a Sarabia drive had spun high off the crossbar. Just before half-time it was 2-0, Gerard Moreno pulling wide and crossing for Laporte to loop a header out of Dubravka's reach.

Djokovic, Barty are top seeds

Defending champion Novak Djokovic was named as the top seed at Wimbledon on Wednesday as he seeks a 20th Grand Slam title while Roger Federer and Serena Williams will begin the grass-court tournament next week seeded seventh.

Top-ranked Ashleigh Barty is seeded first on the women's side. The Australian hasn't played since retiring from her second-round match at the French Open due to the flareup of an upper-leg injury.

The draw is Friday and the tournament begins Monday.

Eighth-ranked Federer has the seventh seed because third-ranked Rafael Nadal is sitting out Wimbledon to rest and recover after his loss to Djokovic in the French Open semifinal.

Gosens' name ascending with Germany

"So, do you want me to take this thing with me now?" It was a rare moment of indecisiveness from Robin Gosens, albeit one he could easily afford. The German left wing-back had been named Heineken Star of the Match after a brilliant performance in the 4-2 victory over Portugal, but it took him a few seconds to realise that the trophy he was holding for the obligatory picture and interview was indeed his for keeps.

He would later describe winning the award as 'gigantic', his goal as "next-level magical" and add that he was experiencing "emotional turmoil" (in a positive sense). If further proof were needed that he has a way with words, it came during his marathon interview session after the game in Munich, conducted in



multiple languages.

"As a character, we all appreciate his presence a lot," explained coach Joachim Löw of the versatile Gosens,

who can also operate in midfield. "He is very straightforward and very lively in the way he communicates. As a person, he is kind of like his football style: always taking a clear position, and no-nonsense."

Gosens' dynamic, aggressive displays in two pre-tournament friendlies earned him a spot in the starting XI, but the 26-year-old gave his coach at Atlanta a huge share of the credit for that achievement. "It seems like these qualities have always been slumbering inside me and [Gian Piero] Gasperini managed to reveal them," he said. "I have to thank him for teasing them out."

He certainly delivered against Portugal, and was a key reason why Germany lived up to their own high standards in a big match for the first time in five years. Or, as a relieved Löw put it: "The tournament has now begun for us."

Keeper Hugo recalls 2016 goal that gave Portugal trophy

France goalkeeper Hugo Lloris remembers well the sinking feeling he had after conceding the goal that gave Portugal the European Championship title five years ago.

The two teams have met since then, as recently as last November when France won in Lisbon to clinch a spot in the Nations League finals, and met again on Wednesday in their last group game at Euro 2020.

But the context of their showdown at Euro 2016 was so different. It was a delicate and poignant time for a French nation recovering from a wave of deadly terror attacks that killed 130 people in Paris in November 2015.

"It was the final of a Euro, with everything it had produced in terms of emotion throughout the whole tournament," Lloris said Tuesday.

"Yes, it is a painful memory because there was this defeat in what was a difficult time for the French."



Wanted to win the trophy for a suffering nation trying to heal, Les Bleus beat Germany to reach the final. Backed by a vocal home

crowd waving red-white-and-blue flags they were favored to win the final on July 10 at Stade de France, especially when Portugal forward Cristiano Ronaldo limped off injured midway through the first half.

France dominated but missed chances. Then, in the last seconds of normal time, substitute Andre-Pierre Gignac hit the post.

After that, the game started turning and unheralded substitute Eder's long-range strike in the second half of extra time bounced just off

of Lloris' outstretched hand and crept inside the post.

Eleven minutes later, France's players sank to the ground with their dreams of a third European title over, while the injured Ronaldo hobbled with delight.

It took time for France to recover from the loss on home soil, but Lloris thinks it ultimately helped motivate the players two years later.

"On the back of it we were able to build our success at the World Cup in Russia, and the two things are most certainly linked," he said.
